Listening for God's "New Normal"

We are anticipating a 'new normal.' We might soon be free from masks and social distancing, but what are we going to be free for? How might a word from the prophet Isaiah help us figure out how *our* new normal can be informed by *God's* new normal? And how might that reflect what God does for and among God's people for the good of the world God loves?

Isaiah 43:14-21 ¹⁴ Thus has said the Lord. the one redeeming you, the Holy One of Israel: "For your sake I have sent to Babylon and I will throw down all the barred gates, and the Chaldeans will wail with lamentation. 15 I am the Lord, your Holy One, the one creating Israel, your king." ¹⁶ Thus has said the Lord, the one giving a way in the sea, and in turbulent waters a pathway, 17 the one leading out chariot and horse, army and warrior together, they lie down, they cannot rise, they are extinguished, like a wick they go out: 18 "Do not remember the former things, and the ancient things do not consider. 19 LOOK! Lam making a new thing, now it springs up, do you not realize it? Indeed, I make in the wilderness a way, in the desert, rivers. ²⁰ The animals of the wilds will honour me, the jackals and the ostriches, For I give in the wilderness waters, rivers in the desert, to give drink to my chosen people, 21 this people whom I formed for myself,

my praise they will proclaim."
